Maintaining Dignity: Understanding and Responding to the Challenges Facing Older LGBT Americans An AARP survey of n=1,762 LGBT adults age 45-plus Annotation of Survey Responses

Community Marketing & Insights (CMI) collected these data from October 27 to November 12, 2017 through an online survey of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (LGBT) Americans age 45 and older. The national sample of n=1,762 LGBT respondents recruited from CMI's proprietary LGBT research panel includes n=627 lesbian or same gender loving females; n=680 gay or same gender loving males; n=162 bisexual or pansexual women and men; and n=264 respondents who identified as one of the following "gender expansive" categories: transgender, trans woman, trans man, gender non-binary, genderqueer, gender fluid or intersex. Gender expansive participants were intentionally oversampled to allow for analysis and data reporting of this segment.

Whereas no gold standard estimate of the LGBT population is currently available from the U.S. Census Bureau or other public data sources, the survey sample was compared to the panel sample frame as well as population data on same-sex households and total US population age 45 and over in order to ensure socio-economic, geographic and demographic ratios were reasonably balanced. Due to the oversample of gender expansive participants, total LGBT results were weighted as 47% male, 47% female and 6% gender expansive.
